

- All exhibitors are to complete the Indemnity and Waiver form and submit with the 2. animal entry form.
- 3. It is the exhibitors/owners responsibility to meet all obligations under the NLIS. The exhibitor/owner is to complete the NLIS Livestock Movement - Form A.
- 4. The age of stud beef cattle shall be the actual age up to and inclusive of 31st March 2014.
- 5. In any protest relative to age the Stewards reserve the right to mouth any exhibit and make the final decision.
- 6. All exhibits must be made available for inspection to persons nominated by the Society at any time, for any reason whatsoever.
- 7. All stock must be eligible for registration with the respective breed societies.
- 8. The Society will not hold itself responsible for any loss or mis-delivery of livestock or other exhibits at the Show or any damage there to.
- Overnight accommodation is available from 4.00 pm on the day prior to Judging. 9.
- 10. All cattle must be on the Showground by 7.30 am and remain until after the Parade or the committee may withhold any trophies, ribbons and/or prizemoney.
- If any exhibitor/exhibit is not ready to parade when the class is called, then that class 11. will go ahead without that exhibitor/exhibit.
- 12. All beef cattle must be paraded with a halter.
- 13. All bulls over 12 months of age must have nose ring and halter.
- 14. Heifer is a female that has not had a calf and is under 24 months of age.
- 15. A calf under 8 months of age may parade with its mother.
- Neck straps, chains or suitable halter must be used on all cattle stalled in cattle sheds. 16.
- 17. Exhibits not stalled or tied in designated areas may be disqualified.
- Sawdust bedding is provided by the Society, other bedding to be supplied by the 18. Exhibitor.
- All exhibitors must send in negative pestivirus results for each beast with entries. 19.
